#### **Influencer Engagement Agreement Terms and Conditions**

These Influencer Engagement Agreement Terms and Conditions are entered into by and between Whatnot Europe Ltd. ("Whatnot") and the influencer ("Influencer") performing services pursuant to a Whatnot Influencer Engagement Agreement, or, as applicable, the lender ("Lender") executing a Whatnot Influencer Engagement Agreement for the services of Influencer, which references or otherwise incorporates these Terms and Conditions. As applicable, all references to 'Influencer' in this Agreement shall be construed as also referring to 'Lender,' unless (i) Influencer and Lender are explicitly differentiated therein, or (ii) the context dictates otherwise. For the avoidance of doubt, this provision does not merge the distinct responsibilities and rights associated with each role where specifically differentiated herein.

- 1. <u>Payment Terms</u>. Whatnot shall pay Influencer or Lender, as applicable, the fees in accordance with the Engagement Terms. Whatnot shall not be liable for any expenses or costs (including, without limitation, agent fees, commissions, residuals, benefits, taxes, etc.) without Whatnot's prior written approval.
- 2. Influencer Social Media and Marketing Commitments. Influencer further agrees to visibly maintain the Deliverables on Influencer's applicable Social Media Sites during the Term of this Agreement and for one (1) year thereafter. Whatnot may provide mutually approved text or content for such posts, which will tag Influencer. Influencer will make all comments and post all Content on the Social Media Sites in accordance with the Social Media Sites' terms of use, all applicable laws (including (but not limited to) all applicable advertising marketing laws and data protection laws) and industry standards, including (but not limited to) the US FTC Guides and the UK CAP and BCAP Codes, the UK Competition and Markets Authority's guidance on social media endorsements, the ASAI Code on advertising in Ireland and all other applicable regulatory guidance. Influencer acknowledges that any approval by the Whatnot of the Deliverables or other Content under this Agreement will not constitute a waiver of Influencer's obligations under this Section 2, nor does the Whatnot's approval confirm that any such Deliverables are lawful. Influencer shall not engage, directly or indirectly, in any act or omission that artificially increases the number of views, likes, comments, or other activities on the Whatnot Platform whether using automatic systems delivering content to users, fake accounts, or interfere with the operation of the Whatnot Platform in the manner that the Whatnot intends.
- 3. Approvals. Influencer agrees to submit the Deliverables in accordance with the terms set forth in the Engagement Terms. In addition, Influencer will not post any Deliverable to Influencer's websites or social channels unless such Deliverable is approved by Whatnot in writing (email being sufficient). If Whatnot believes that any Deliverable is unacceptable because of tone, quality, or other factors, Whatnot may, in its sole discretion, disapprove such Deliverable and communicate the reason to Influencer. Influencer will have two (2) business days to revise such Deliverable and resubmit such Deliverable to Whatnot for re-evaluation/approval, unless the posting schedule requires a shorter time period.

## 4. Representations and Warranties.

a. Influencer and/or Lender, as applicable, represents and warrants that: (i) Influencer has the right and authority to enter into this Agreement, and does not have any conflict or commitment that would impair the performance of this Agreement or rights granted; (ii) the material, services, Deliverables, Content and Livestreams rendered, used or provided by Influencer in connection with this Agreement ('Influencer Content') will be timely rendered and will be of first-rate quality and in compliance with Section B and all applicable laws, regulations and guidelines; (iii) all Influencer Content provided by Influencer in connection with this Agreement will be original, and will not breach any intellectual property rights or other rights of a third party, nor will such Influencer Content in whole or in part, be libellous or defamatory to any person or brand or company/organization or otherwise illegal; (iv) Influencer owns or has the necessary licenses, rights, consents, and permissions (including all applicable music rights) to grant the rights and permissions granted to Whatnot hereunder, and the exercise or rights by Whatnot in and to the Influencer Content does not and will not infringe or breach third party intellectual property rights or rights of publicity or privacy or require any additional licenses, permissions or clearances by Whatnot; (v) Influencer will remove, replace or

modify any materials, Deliverables, Content and Livestreams at Whatnot's request; and (vi) Influencer will follow all Whatnot messaging and content guidelines at all times. Influencer further represents and warrants that the Influencer is not a member of SAG-AFTRA or any other union, clan, or guild, and that the services detailed herein are not SAG-AFTRA productions or productions under any other union, clan, or guild agreement. If Lender is entering into this Agreement on behalf of the Influencer, then the Influencer confirms and agrees to be bound by all grants, warranties, representations and obligations of the Lender and agrees to perform the services provided for in accordance with the terms set forth in the Agreement, and Influencer will look solely to the Lender for any and all compensation hereunder, and for the discharge of all other obligations of Whatnot with respect to Influencer's services hereunder.

- b. Whatnot represents and warrants that: (i) it has the right and authority to enter into this Agreement, and does not have any conflict or commitment that would impair the services of rights granted; and (ii) Whatnot owns or has the necessary licenses, rights, consents, and permissions to grant the rights and permissions granted to Influencer hereunder.
- 5. Confidential Information. Each party will keep in confidence the other party's Confidential Information unless (i) such information becomes public, not due to a breach hereof by the receiving party or is otherwise received by the receiving party from a third party without a duty of confidentiality; (ii) is independently developed without breach of this Agreement; or (iii) is required to be disclosed by law, court order or a subpoena, in which case the receiving party will notify the disclosing party and only disclose the minimum amount of information necessary. Each party agrees that the terms of the Engagement Terms (including all payment information) will be deemed confidential and may not be disclosed without the prior written consent of the other party. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the terms of this Agreement may be disclosed on a confidential basis to a party's advisors, attorneys, actual or bona-fide potential acquirers, investors or other sources of funding (and their respective advisors and attorneys) for due diligence purposes.

## 6. Ownership; Grant of Rights

- a. Whatnot Platform. As between Influencer on the one hand and Whatnot on the other hand, Whatnot, is the sole and exclusive owner of all right, title, and interest in and to the Whatnot Materials. Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement and the Terms of Service, Whatnot grants Influencer a limited, revocable, personal, non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-sublicensable right and license to use the Whatnot Materials solely in connection with the performance of the services.
- b. Influencer Content. Except for any Whatnot Materials and any derivatives thereof, Influencer will retain ownership in all of the Livestreams and Deliverables, including any intellectual property rights in and to the Livestreams and/or Deliverables. Notwithstanding the foregoing, during the Term, Influencer hereby grants to Whatnot and its Affiliates a worldwide, irrevocable, fully paid-up, royalty-free, transferable and sublicensable right and license to copy, use, reproduce, modify, adapt, publish, post, translate, create derivative works from, distribute, transmit, and display the Livestreams and/or Deliverables, and content generated therefrom, in whole or in part and for any lawful purpose in all unpaid and/or organic media now known or hereafter devised, including but not limited to organic social media, usage in-app and on the Whatnot Platform, promotion of Whatnot, its Affiliates and their products and services, unpaid digital media, on brand owned and operated channels (i.e. website, social channels, newsletters, in-app/on platform, etc.) and email. With respect to any Supplemental Deliverables, as applicable, in addition to the foregoing, Influencer hereby grants to Company and its Affiliates a worldwide, irrevocable, fully paid-up, royalty-free, transferable and sublicensable right and license to copy, use, reproduce, modify, adapt, publish, post, translate, create derivative works from, distribute, transmit, and display the Supplemental Deliverables, and content generated therefrom, in whole or in part for all paid media now known or hereafter devised, including but not limited to paid social media, whitelisting and dark posting on social media, paid advertisement, usage in-app and on the Whatnot Platform, promotion of Company, its Affiliates and their products and services, digital media, brand owned and operated channels (i.e. website, social channels, newsletters, in-app/on platform, etc.) and PR during the Usage Period. With respect to the Supplemental Deliverables, all rights granted in this Section

- 6(b) shall be granted for the duration of the Usage Period.
- c. Influencer's Name and Likeness. To the extent any Livestreams or Deliverables include Influencer IP, during the Term, Influencer hereby further grants to Whatnot and its Affiliates a worldwide, irrevocable, fully paid up, royalty-free, and fully sublicensable right and license and all necessary permission and consent to use, reproduce, publish, distribute, transmit, and display the Influencer IP, in connection with Whatnot's and its Affiliates' use of the Livestreams, Deliverables, and the Whatnot Platform in any and all unpaid and/or organic media, now known or hereafter devised in accordance with this Agreement. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein: (a) Whatnot and its Affiliates will have no obligation to take down, disable or remove any Influencer IP from any Livestream, nor will Whatnot and its Affiliates be obligated to remove any social media or other promotional communications using Influencer IP previously disseminated during the Term; (b) Influencer agrees that all Livestreams may remain live and be maintained on the Whatnot Platform following the end of the Term; and (c) with respect to the Supplemental Deliverables, the rights granted in this Section 6(c) shall be granted for the duration of the Usage Period.
- d. Limited Trademark License Grant. Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, each of Whatnot and Influencer grants to the other party a worldwide, royalty-free, non-exclusive, and non-transferable right and license to use and reproduce the other party's Marks, solely as necessary to perform this Agreement. Any use by one party of the other party's Marks must be in accordance with applicable law and usage guidelines such other party may provide from time to time and otherwise in accordance with this Agreement. Each party acknowledges and agrees that any and all goodwill and other proprietary rights that are created by or that result from such party's use of the other party's Marks as permitted hereunder inure solely to the benefit of the other party.
- e. **Data protection**. Where the Influencer processes personal data in its performance of this Agreement the Influencer agrees that the Influencer does so as an independent controller data (as defined in EU Regulation 2016/679) ('GDPR') and undertakes to Whatnot to comply with applicable data protection laws and other applicable laws relating to processing data and marketing by electronic communications, including (but not limited to) (i) the GDPR; and (ii) data protection and privacy laws in the United Kingdom. The Influencer shall not transfer (e.g. by sharing or making available) personal data to Whatnot in the performance of this Agreement, including (but not limited to) its performance of the obligations relating to 'Deliverables', including as described in "Data and Metric" as described in section "Deliverables" above. The Influencer agrees that it is necessary for Whatnot to process the Influencer's personal data in connection with Whatnot's performance of this Agreement.
- 7. Morals. Influencer (i) has not committed and will not commit any act which may bring Influencer or Whatnot, in Whatnot's sole discretion, by association, into public disrepute, contempt, scandal or ridicule, or which may insult or offend the public or any protected group or class thereof including, without limitation, the general community to which Whatnot and/or Whatnot's products or services are directed, and as such, may reflect unfavorably upon the reputation of Whatnot or its products or services through Whatnot's association with Influencer, irrespective of whether such act is related to Influencer's services and of the length of time that has elapsed since such act was committed; and (ii) has not and will not during the Term, make public damaging statements regarding Whatnot, Whatnot's products, the Whatnot Platform or Influencer's association with Whatnot in a manner that, may discredit Whatnot, compare the Whatnot Platform with products of a competitor, or injure the success of Whatnot or any of Whatnot's products or services, including the Whatnot Platform.

## 8. Termination.

a. Either party may terminate this Agreement immediately in the event of a material breach by the other party, which breach remains uncured for a period of fifteen (15) calendar days after notice of such breach is delivered to the breaching party if such breach is curable. Whatnot may terminate this Agreement: (i) for convenience upon fifteen (15) calendar days prior written notice to Influencer; (ii) immediately, without

- notice, in the event Whatnot does not approve any resubmitted Deliverables (as such term is used in Section 4 of these Terms and Conditions); or (iii) immediately, without notice, in the event of a breach by Influencer of Section 7 of these Terms and Conditions or any Non-Compete obligations set forth in the Engagement Terms (if any).
- b. In the event of termination for convenience by Whatnot, Influencer will be entitled to the Pro-Rated Fee. In the event of termination of this Agreement by Whatnot for any other reason, all payment or consideration to Influencer shall cease immediately without further obligation on Whatnot, and, if applicable, Influencer shall promptly refund Whatnot a pro rata portion of any pre-paid fees for services or Deliverables not yet provided as of the effective date of termination. If Whatnot has previously paid Influencer an amount equal to or higher than the Pro-Rated Fee, then no further payment shall be made by Whatnot. If any sums are due to Influencer, Whatnot shall pay such amounts to Influencer in accordance with this Agreement. Upon expiration or termination of this Agreement, Influencer will cease all promotional activities in support of Whatnot and each party will return or, at the disclosing party's election, destroy the Confidential Information of the other party or parties. Whatnot will have no obligation to remove or otherwise cause the removal of any Influencer IP after the Term in Livestreams posted during Term. Termination shall not affect a party's accrued rights and obligations at the date of termination. Clauses which are expressed to survive its termination or which from their nature or context are contemplated to survive termination shall remain in full force and effect notwithstanding termination of this Agreement.

### 9. Indemnity.

- a. Influencer or Lender, as applicable, agree to defend, indemnify, and hold Whatnot and its Affiliates, officers, directors, employees, business partners, agents, successors, and assigns harmless from and against any and all Claims of any kind arising out of or related to: (i) any breach or alleged breach of its representations, warranties or obligations hereunder; (ii) any Claim that the Livestreams or Deliverables infringe a third party's intellectual property rights; (iii) Section 12 of these Terms and Conditions; (iv) breach of the Influencer Code of Conduct set forth in Exhibit A; (v) Claims that Influencer is an employee of Whatnot or otherwise directly owed any benefits or compensation by Whatnot; and/or (vi) any gross negligence or willful misconduct of Influencer.
- b. Whatnot will indemnify, defend, and hold Influencer harmless from and against any third-party Claims arising out of or related to: (i) gross negligence or willful misconduct of Whatnot; (ii) any breach of Whatnot's representations or warranties hereunder; and/or (iii) the authorized and unmodified use of any Whatnot furnished materials.
- c. The indemnified party will promptly notify the indemnifying party in writing of any Claim. The indemnifying party, at its sole cost, will assume defense of the Claim, provided that the indemnifying party may not enter into a settlement agreement without the prior written consent of the indemnified party, which consent will not be unreasonably withheld, and the indemnified party will have the right to participate in its defense at its sole expense. Whatnot may at any time assume the defense of any Claim, at Influencer's sole expense, if Influencer does not proceed in a timely manner or if Whatnot deems, in its sole discretion, that the Claim may harm or otherwise tarnish Whatnot's reputation or otherwise be prejudicial to its interests.
- 10. <u>Taxes</u>. The fees payable to Influencer or, as applicable, to Lender for the services of Influencer, are inclusive of, and Influencer will be solely responsible for any and all Taxes with respect to any earnings or payments made hereunder, whether or not Whatnot is legally required to deduct said Taxes from the payments due to Influencer. Influencer will not be entitled to any benefits paid or made available by Whatnot to its employees, including, without limitation, any vacation or illness payments, or to participate in any plans, arrangements or distributions made by Whatnot pertaining to any bonus, stock option, profit sharing, insurance or similar benefits. Influencer will indemnify and hold Whatnot harmless from and against any and all Claims arising out of or relating to any employment claims made by Influencer or any obligation imposed by law on Whatnot to pay any withholding taxes, social security, unemployment or disability insurance or similar

items in connection with any compensation received by Influencer pursuant to this Agreement.

- 11. <u>VAT and Invoices</u>. All sums payable under this Agreement are exclusive of value added tax, which (if applicable) shall be payable by Whatnot after the receipt by Whatnot of the Influencer's valid VAT invoice for the relevant sum in a form acceptable to Whatnot. The Fees shall be invoiced by the Influencer in accordance with the Statement of Work. The Influencer agrees and acknowledges that the Fees are equitable and adequate remuneration for the rights granted under this Agreement, both on the Effective Date, during the Term and in respect of all future use.
- 12. <u>Limitation of Liability; Disclaimer</u>. NOTHING IN THIS AGREEMENT EXCLUDES OR LIMITS EITHER PARTY'S LIABILITY FOR ANY LIABILITY WHICH MAY NOT BE LIMITED OR EXCLUDED BY APPLICABLE LAW (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO LIABILITY FOR DEATH OR PERSONAL INJURY CAUSED BY NEGLIGENCE AND FRAUD OR FRAUDULENT MISREPRESENTATION). WHATNOT WILL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY SPECIAL, INDIRECT, CONSEQUENTIAL, EXEMPLARY, OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES OR ANY LOST REVENUE OR LOST PROFITS. WHATNOT'S AGGREGATE LIABILITY UNDER THIS AGREEMENT WILL NOT EXCEED THE FEES PAYABLE TO INFLUENCER UNDER THIS AGREEMENT.
- 13. Relationship of the Parties. This Agreement creates no partnership, fiduciary, employment, or other professional relationship between the parties. Neither party will have the power to bind the other or to incur obligations on the other's behalf without such other party's prior written consent. Each party understands and agrees that they will not be considered an employee of the other party for any purpose, including Tax obligations, and will not be entitled to and expressly waives any claim for employment benefits of any kind from the other party or parties. In addition, Influencer acknowledges and agrees that it will be their responsibility to maintain such health, liability, hazard, personal injury and other insurance policies as Influencer deems reasonably necessary in necessary to perform their duties hereunder
- 14. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which will constitute an original, and all of which will constitute one and the same instrument. Electronic signatures will have the same weight and effect as originals.
- 15. <u>Survival</u>. The rights and obligations contained in Sections 4, 5, 6(a)-(c), and 7 through and including 17 of these Terms and Conditions will survive any termination or expiration of this Agreement.
- 16. Governing Law; Venue. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of Ireland and each party agrees that any dispute (contractual or non-contractual) arising out of or in connection with this Agreement including any question regarding its existence, validity or termination shall be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Irish courts. For clarity, any and all claims or other disputes arising from this Agreement are subject to this Section 16. Claims or other disputes otherwise arising from or relating to the Whatnot Platform are governed by the dispute resolution provisions of the Terms of Service applicable to the Whatnot Platform.
- 17. Miscellaneous. This Agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties concerning the subject matter herein and supersedes any other oral or written agreements between the parties regarding this matter. No modification to this Agreement will be valid unless in a writing signed by the parties. If any part, term, or provision of this Agreement will be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, unenforceable, or in conflict with any relevant law, the remaining portions or provisions will still remain valid and continue in full force and effect. No waiver, express or implied, by either party of any term or condition or of any breach by the other party of any of the provisions of this Agreement will operate as a waiver of any breach of the same or any other provision of this Agreement. Influencer acknowledges that a breach or threatened breach of this Agreement could cause Whatnot irreparable harm and that, without prejudice to any other rights or remedies under this Agreement, nothing shall prevent Whatnot from seeking preliminary or temporary injunctive relief in connection with this Agreement in a court of competent jurisdiction. In the event that any conflict exists among the terms and conditions of this Agreement and the terms and conditions of the Terms of Service, the order of precedence shall be: (i) these Terms and Conditions; (ii) the Influencer Code of Conduct; (iii) the Engagement Terms; and (iv) the Terms of Service. This Agreement will be binding upon and inure to the benefit of each of the parties hereto and their respective permitted heirs, successors, and assigns. Influencer may not under any circumstance (except for any assignment of payment) assign or transfer its rights or obligations hereunder without Whatnot's prior written consent. Any attempt to assign or transfer this Agreement without such consent will be void. Whatnot may assign or transfer this Agreement for any reason including to any of its parents, subsidiaries, and Affiliates and including with respect to the sale of

substantially all or all of Whatnot's stock, assets or business, and any other merger, consolidation, or other change of control of Whatnot.

## 18. Definitions.

- a. "Affiliate" means, with respect to any party, any entity that directly or indirectly controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with a party, now or anytime in the future. For purposes of this definition, "control" means having ownership of the majority of the voting securities of such party.
- b. "Claims" means claims, damages, obligations, losses, liabilities, costs or debt, and expenses (including but not limited to attorney's fees) arising from any third-party claims, suits, actions, settlements, or judgments.
- c. "Code of Conduct" means the Influencer code of conduct set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.
- d. "Confidential Information" means a party's confidential or proprietary information that is designated in writing to the other party as confidential or which should otherwise be reasonably deemed confidential.
- e. "Excluded Claims" means Influencer's indemnification obligations or any breach of confidentiality or exclusivity by Influencer.
- f. "FTC Guides" means the Federal Trade Commission's Guides Concerning Endorsements and Testimonials in Advertising, available at <a href="https://www.ftc.gov/sites/default/files/attachments/press-releases/ftc-publishes-final-guides-governing-endorsements-testimonials/091005revisedendorsementguides.pdf">https://www.ftc.gov/sites/default/files/attachments/press-releases/ftc-publishes-final-guides-governing-endorsements-testimonials/091005revisedendorsementguides.pdf</a>
- g. "Influencer's IP" means Influencer's name, voice, signature, image, and likeness and related statements, comments and remarks and all other persona or other attributable rights.
- h. "Marks" mean a party's trademarks, service marks, logos, slogans, and trade names, all applications, registrations, and renewals in connection therewith, and all goodwill associated therewith throughout the world.
- i. "Pro-Rated Fee" means the undisputed amounts due for the services and Deliverables performed by the Influencer and accepted by Whatnot as of the date of such termination (i.e., the pro rata portion of any compensation paid or payable to Influencer up to and including the date of such termination) calculated by multiplying the remaining unpaid amount of the Fee by a fraction, the denominator of which is the total number of Deliverables to be posted by Influencer's on the Influencer Social Media Sites pursuant to the Engagement Terms and the numerator of which is the number of Deliverables actually posted on Influencer's Social Media Sites.
- j. "Social Media Sites" means Influencer's Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, TikTok, and other social media pages.
- k. "*Taxes*" means any and all tax obligations due to all taxing authorities arising from or in connection with amounts paid to Influencer hereunder.
- I. "*Terms of Service*" means the Whatnot Terms of Service available at <a href="https://whatnot.com/terms">https://whatnot.com/terms</a>, which are incorporated by this reference into this Agreement.
- m. "Usage Period" means, with respect to each Supplemental Deliverable, the period commencing as of Company's first public use of such Supplemental Deliverable and continuing for ninety (90) days thereafter.
- n. "Whatnot Materials" means the Whatnot Platform, all content, taglines, and other creative assets developed or made available by Whatnot in connection with the Whatnot Platform, the Whatnot brand and Marks, and this Agreement, including all intellectual property rights in and to the foregoing.

# **EXHIBIT A**

Whatnot believes in full transparency and in full, fair, and effective disclosures of material facts relating to Influencer's relationship with Whatnot. Accordingly, Whatnot requires that Influencer adhere to any applicable laws (including (but not limited to) all applicable advertising marketing law), regulations, industry standards and guidance (including (but not limited to), in the US, the Federal Trade Commission's Guides Concerning Endorsements and Testimonials in Advertising ("FTC Guides"), available at <a href="https://www.ftc.gov/sites/default/files/attachments/press-releases/ftc-publishes-final-guides-governing-endorsements-testimonials/091005revisedendorsementguides.pdf">https://www.ftc.gov/sites/default/files/attachments/press-releases/ftc-publishes-final-guides-governing-endorsements-testimonials/091005revisedendorsementguides.pdf</a>, and in the UK, the Competition and Markets Authority's guidance on social media endorsements, available at <a href="https://www.asa.org.uk/resource/influencers-guide.html">https://www.asa.org.uk/resource/influencers-guide.html</a>) including without limitation, when publishing the Livestreams or any other content about Whatnot or any of Whatnot's products or services, or when otherwise posting or streaming about or for the benefit of Whatnot or its products or services. Please note that all capitalized terms used but not defined herein will have the respective meaning given to them in the Statement of Work or in the Terms and Conditions.

- 1. Clear and Prominent Disclosure of Material Connections. Influencer understands that Influencer's connection with Whatnot might materially affect the weight or credibility consumers give to Influencer's statement(s). For this reason, Influencer will not post or otherwise speak about or refer to Whatnot, directly or indirectly, without disclosing such connection, including, without limitation, the fact that Influencer was afforded any consideration, benefits, or received any free products or services from Whatnot. Such disclosure must appear clearly and conspicuously and in close proximity to any statements Influencer makes about Whatnot, Whatnot's products and services, and/or the services performed regardless of the space limitations of the medium. Influencer agrees that any consumer should not be required to click on, scroll down or mouse over a link in order to view the disclosure, the disclosure should not be buried in a list of hashtags, the disclosure should not be in a colour that contrasts poorly with the background, and the disclosure should appear before the "click to read more" button. If a video is being created, the disclosure must be included in the video itself and also in the caption below or above the video or in the title of the video or thumbnail. If Influencer is streaming, Influencer should ensure that Influencer both discloses in a voice-over and superimpose a disclosure periodically during the stream. The specific form of any such disclosure (which may for example include the hashtags #ad or #advertisement) will either be provided to Influencer by Whatnot, or otherwise approved by Whatnot, or mutually agreed upon by Influencer and Whatnot, but at all times in compliance with the applicable law and guidance. If Influencer has any questions on what it means to be in compliance in the US, Influencer can access the FTC's FAQ here: https://www.ftc.gov/tipsadvice/business-center/quidance/ftcs-endorsement-quides-what-people-are-asking.
- 2. <u>Influencer's Honest and Truthful Opinions</u>. Influencer's statements must reflect Influencer's honest and truthful opinions, findings, beliefs, or experiences. When representing that he/she uses Whatnot's products or services, Influencer must be a bona fide user of such products or services at the time the statement is given. Generally, Influencer should only make factual statements about Whatnot or Whatnot's products or services which Influencer knows to be true, and which can be verified. Moreover, Influencer's statements must not convey any express or implied representation that would be deceptive, a misrepresentation, or fraudulent if made directly by Whatnot.
- 3. No Inappropriate Language or Content. Influencer agrees that all Influencer Content will always be in good taste and free of inappropriate or illegal language and/or content. Influencer shall ensure that the Influencer Content does not:
  - a. Contain material that is inappropriate, indecent, obscene, hateful, tortious, defamatory, slanderous, libellous, obscene or likely to cause offence or harm;
  - b. Contain material that otherwise promotes bigotry, racism or discrimination against an individual based on race, gender, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation, or age;
  - c. Contain material that is unlawful, in breach of or contrary to the laws or regulations of the jurisdiction where content is created:
  - d. Contain information known by Influencer to be false, inaccurate, or misleading;
  - e. Contain material or content for which Influencer has been compensated or granted any consideration by any third party;
  - f. Incite violence, contain material harmful to any third party, not does not depict dangerous, criminal, terrorist

acts, or encourage anti-social behaviour.

- g. Disparage Whatnot or any other person or party; and/or
- h. Contain material not consistent with the image and values of Whatnot or otherwise associates Whatnot, the Whatnot Platform or any of Whatnot's products or services with any inappropriate or controversial content that would reflect poorly upon Whatnot, the Whatnot Platform, the Whatnot's products or services or any products or services on Whatnot's sites or channels, including the Whatnot Platform;
- i. And understands that such Influencer Content may be rejected by Whatnot
